Project Summary

The Upper Juniata River Watershed Wetland Study was funded through the United States Environmental Protection Agency. The project team consisted of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, Southern Alleghenies Conservancy, Penn State University, and Melius & Hockenberry Environmental Services, Inc. Throughout summer 2000, 83 wetland sites were assessed in order to provide an overall view of the condition of wetlands within the watershed.
